

AIRAYA WirelessGRID™ CCTV Surveillance Network for 2006 International Monetary Fund World Bank Group Boards of Governors Annual Meetings Deployment

The Singapore Police Force (SPF) set up a comprehensive outdoor digital wireless video surveillance system for its security operations during the 2006 International Monetary Fund World Bank Group Boards of Governors Annual Meetings that was held at the Suntec Singapore International Convention and Exhibition Centre (SSICEC), Singapore in September 2006. For the event, outdoor Pan-Tilt-Zoom speed dome cameras were mounted on strategically selected street lamp-posts at busy areas including the Raffles City, and SSICEC vicinity. These cameras were connected wirelessly, through AIRAYA WirelessGRID™ base stations at selected buildings, to Police's monitoring centres for viewing and recording. There were also close to a hundred outdoor cameras covering the Suntec and Raffles City areas throughout the event. This is the first large-scale outdoor real-time video surveillance system implemented in Singapore using state-of-the-art digital high-speed wireless network infrastructure and components for the transmission of camera video streams across a wide area of coverage.
